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
Tybee Island is located at exactly 32 degrees north latitude. The actual 32 degree line runs right through Tybee and crosses the USA all the way to San Diego!

I am absolutely beside myself to have this article in the Beachcomber! Tybee has one of their very own competing in this year's Westminster 2nd Annual Dock Diving competition!! Only the elite of the elite compete in this world class dog show, the Westminster and Tybee is extremely well represented by Jenny Orr's pooch, Four on the Floor Louie LaMour! Read on in Jenny's own words how this came to be and where we can watch it and root on our hero!

What a fun time I have with this little guy! He has been my ride or die thru Covid, Alzheimer's and Cancer. Never any down time, always something to do with a Jack Russell! I forgot how old I was when I decided to get one!

After my last Wolfhound passed, I decided to get a small dog I could take everywhere with me. I had a Jack Russell before and decided to get another. It was during Covid and I tried for about 6 months to adopt a rescue terrier, but there were hardly any available and none who were dog and cat friendly to be found. I searched around the web, looking at different breeders, and finally picked one in Texas at Rock Bottom Kennels. Angela Richmond proudly raises the original "Go get em' JRTs." She was my kind of dog person and bred beautiful and athletic dogs. I actually got to pick the mating pair. She warned me in her very Texas drawl, "This is going to be a veeerrry driven dog!" I was like, "No problem."

Good Lord, I truly underestimated her words! To keep him busy I signed us up for a Barn Hunt class in March of 2022 at Dog Gone Sensational Dogs in Ridgeland, SC, and that is when we saw the Diving Dock!! Louie loves the water, and I loved watching the sport, so we signed up for classes and this is where our love of Dock Diving began, with classes by owner Janet Rahn.

Our first competition was a few weeks later in Perry, Ga. He jumped at Masters level 14.9 feet, earning a Masters Title (13-17 feet) in April of 2022, his first time out. By June he was jumping consistently over 18 feet and earned his Elite Title (over 18 feet) with North American Diving Dogs. He has since earned his Dock Elite Advanced Title, and in August of 2023 he earned his Dock Elite Excellent Title. His YTD Average for 2023 was 19.7 feet for 54 qualifying jumps. His personal best so far is 20.6 feet!! Amazing when you consider he is 13.5 inches tall and 20 lbs.! Such a great athlete. In 2023 he also earned his AKC Canine Good Citizen Title and his AKC Trick Dog Novice Title. BTW, I throw a football for his last jump in every competition! Hehehe!

He has been invited back to 2024 Westminster for the 2nd annual Dock Diving competition on Saturday May 11th. He was also invited last year in 2023 and took 2nd place in Lap Dog Elite Class. It was an amazing experience to watch such amazing athletes and incredibly beautiful show dogs. We are all working hard toward taking the Blue Ribbon this year at the Westminster Dock Diving Competition!

You can watch on Fox Sports or Stream on YouTube and the WKC app. We got a fun surprise earlier this year. Louie's obedience trainer, Cindi McManus, who owns Noble Beasts and Windi Williams-Weaver, Agility at Morningstar Clever Canines, had each forwarded us an email circulating around, looking for a Jack Russell Terrier to do an ad for a major dog treat company. I didn't apply at first and then the email recirculated... So I put together a little Bio of Louie and about 20 pics and videos. Lo and Behold ... the producers picked Louie for the Ad. We went to Nashville in March and did a photo shoot for Pedigree!! Louie will be the dog on the new Pedigree Dentastix box/bag! This dog!

Root for us to take the Blue Ribbon this year at Westminster Dock Diving! Been such a fun journey with... Four on the Floor, Louie LaMour... Follow us at #Teamlouie1. In the end this little dog has brought so much joy into my life. His drive and determination amaze me and reminds me that it is all in the "trying" that you get the reward and satisfaction of achievement.

I think. It's truly a pleasure to compile this 600-word masterpiece every month for you Tybee Island readers, OK, that's enough grandstanding, it's spring and lots of sports to cover so let's hop to it.

One of the most wonderful sporting events in the world wrapped up in Augusta with the coronation of Scottie Sheffler as a two-time Masters champion. The weather and wind were brutal the first two days, but the weekend offered a sun splashed course, fast greens and stellar play from the person that everyone thought would win in the first place. Between his consistent and superb play on Sunday, and the others finding their demise in sand traps and water around Augusta National, Scheffler won, going away to don the green jacket. The young Swedish player Ludvig Aberg came in second, playing for the first time and is someone that will compete for many tournaments and majors to come. A lot of folks were rooting for Max Homa to win his first major, but he, like others, including two-time major champion Colin Morikawa, faded under the pressure of the second nine on Sunday at Augusta. The biggest storyline is that Spencer Strider, the team's ace pitcher, suffered an early season injury and is lost for the season. He will face a long recovery after surgery on his elbow and arm. 

But this isn't just any parade. Beach Walks with Dr. Joe

OLIVE SNAILS & THEIR TRAILS

When I get home from a Tybee Beach Ecology Trip, my wife will usually ask two questions: "How was your trip?" and "Did you find any Olive shells?" Lettered Olives are her favorite shell to find on Tybee. They really are one of the prettiest shells we find around here. Fresh ones are polished and glossy with lots of tiny triangular arrangements of darker and lighter lines that appear to make "letters" like M's, V's, and W's. No two Lettered Olive shells have the same patterns, so each shell is unique.

My wife likes empty Olive shells, but I'm more excited about finding live Olive Snails. They live along Tybee's beach year-round, but from my experience, it's normally during May when we sometimes find live ones by the dozens burrowing through our wet intertidal zone sand at low tide. Some of them might be lying on top of the sand, but most of them will be burrowing just below the surface, so you might walk right past them unless you know what to look for.

As it burrows through the sand, an Olive Snail makes a trail that looks like somebody dragged their finger or a stick across the wet sand, making a shallow narrow trench. If you see a hump of sand at one end, that is probably where the actual digging snail is. Sometimes it may have just started digging, so there isn't much of a trench, but more of just a small disturbance where the sand is slightly lifted up. If you see that, check under that bump and you might find the live snail.

Lettered Olives are predators, and they are hunting for small animals living in the wet sand. They plow through the sand using their muscular foot, and pulling their streamlined torpedo-shaped shell. They also make lots of slime





that helps when digging through the sand. When an Olive Snail finds its prey, it surrounds it with its foot, suffocates it, and then eats it. Those empty Coquina clam shells that look like tiny colored angel wings, that you sometimes find in the sand, are all that is left after being captured by a Lettered Olive Snail.

You can tell if you've found a live Lettered Olive Snail by looking inside the shell. If it's alive, you'll be able to see a portion of the beige-colored muscular foot just inside. You don't want to keep a live one. It's just going to die and stink. And Tybee protects its shore life and doesn't allow removal of live animals from the beach. Instead, dig it a little hole in the wet sand with your finger, put it in there, and cover it up. It will be safe down there til the tide comes back in.
