

MOVIE REVIEW



BULLET TRAIN

With everything available and directly dialed into our homes these days, it truly is a miracle that anyone ever manages to leave their house. Joey Green has returned to his childhood home in Beaufort, SC to spend some quality time with his ailing father, Marshall Green, and to give his mother some much-needed relief. It seems that Marshall Green, who is a retired doctor, has a bad case of dementia and he has lost almost all of his short-term memory. Although he can’t remember if he ate breakfast five minutes after finishing his meal, he can remember vivid details about the past. When his dad starts talking to an imaginary person named Trip Patterson and Joey has no idea who this person is, he starts asking questions. He also finds out that his dad hates a man named Thomas Hammond who is developing an island to make condos. Joey wants to know what any of these things have to do with his dad’s sudden memory of things that happened years ago.

After Joey convinces his mother to go to Florida for three days for a pickleball tournament, he plans to take his dad out fishing. He books a trip with Bubba, a local fishing guide and longtime friend of the family, and goes to the shed to get the fishing gear together. His dad always kept a gun in his tackle box and Joey finds that the gun is no longer there.


In the meantime, Joey is hooked up with Leela, the divorced daughter of the next-door neighbors, who’s home visiting from Ohio. They hit it off and it looks like the beginning of a long-distance relationship. One night while his mother is gone and after Joey puts his father to bed, he makes sure all the doors are locked and slips out for a midnight rendezvous with Leela. When he gets home at 7 a.m. he finds his father still sound asleep, but the backdoor is unlocked. Did he forget to lock it?

Belinda Flanigan left this life November 28th having just turned 65 in July.

She was everywhere doing something to help make someone's day brighter or better. The Crab Shack, which she ran with her business partner (her ex-husband and best friend), provided well-paying jobs for hundreds over the past 40 years. She served for years on Tybee's Tourism Council, she was a founding sponsor of Tybee's MLK Human Rights Organization, and an active member of American Legion Post 154 women's auxiliary.

Belinda was lovingly called "Queen B" by everyone who knew her and she lived up to that QUEEN title over and over, holding the titles of Beach Bum Queen, Queen of Pirate's Fest, Mardi Gras Queen, and generally Queen of the hearts of all her friends. There were only two groups of people in her life. Her friends and the friends she had yet to meet!

At fund raising, she was epic! Whether someone needed a little help paying their utilities, or needed help rebuilding a fire damaged home, or had medical bills that overwhelmed, she was at the forefront with her team of friends, and monies were raised to meet the need at hand. When there was a death in the family on Tybee, she saw that food was there. When Friends of the Tybee Theater needed money to help refurbish the building, her team raised significant money for that cause and she continued to support by doing her famous Wine Festival brunch for many years. Every year for 9 years, her Tybee Team raised money for the American Diabetes Association. She was always there for the American Legion, The Humane Society, and Coastal Pet Rescue.

Belinda teamed with the Tybee Marine Rescue Squadron to create the Tybee Kid's Fishing Tournament each June. In 2022, the "kids" who fished as entrants in her early tournaments over the past 35 years were registering THEIR kids to "get hooked on fishing, not drugs."

Belinda was a supporter of all Tybee business and could often be seen out with friends at local restaurants. Her libation of choice was a Miller Lite or glass of Chardonnay. So, whether you were a friend or whether you are a friend she had yet to meet, know we have lost a true Tybee treasure. Ask anyone who knew her.

And for those friends who are grieving this loss and will grieve this loss forever, think about these lyrics by Adam Levine and raise a toast to her memory:

*"Here's to the ones we've got. Here's to the wish you were here but you're not.
But, the drinks bring back all the memories of everything we've been through.
Toast to the ones here today. Toast to the ones we have lost on the way,



THE Fish Whisperer

Jan. Fishing Forecast

Welcome to the New Year. Let's start this journey around the sun again and see what is in store for us. I cannot forecast your day-to-day life, nor would I even attempt it. Fishing is my passion, and I can take a shot at predicting what fish will be around during the up coming months.



INSHORE

January tends to be a slow month for the Inshore fishery. The Redfish and Speckled Sea Trout tend to be much of the catch for those fishing the sounds and rivers along coastal Georgia. For those that venture closer to the brackish waters, the Striped Bass bite is also fired up. Ever major river along the coast has a population of Striped Bass and many overlook this fishery. For Redfish I tend to look around the oyster rakes and mudflats on the warmer days. These fish should be schooled up and once you find them you can catch a limit quick. Don't give up, they are around.

NEARSHORE

One of my favorite things this time of year is the nearshore fishing inside 25 miles. When the seas are calm and the winds lay down, it's so much fun to head out to the reefs and target the Sheepshead, Black Drum, and Black Sea Bass. All of these fish are fantastic eating and its not hard to feed your family or have a neighborhood fish fry this time of year. Now the American Red Snapper population had exploded due to the years of our government preventing us from accessing this great fishery. Do not get caught keeping these fish, you will pay the fine. Make sure to have a descending device to help these fish get back down to the bottom. Maybe our government will one day let us keep these delicious fish. For the Sheepshead, Fiddler Crabs are the best bait. I always take a few pounds of live Shrimp this time of year for the Black Drum. Some of these fish are well over 50 pounds and can provide a lot of fun and excitement to your day.



OFFSHORE

Finally, the offshore and Gulf stream bites are always great this time of year. Grouper season just closed, but there are plenty of other fish to keep, Triggerfish being one of my favorites. I take these tasty fish and make Ceviche out of them. Yummy! This time of year is also great time to target Wahoo and Blackfin Tuna out in the Gulf stream. Nothing gets those Wahoo better than high-speed trolling a cowbell or two. For the Tuna, make sure you have those Cedar Plugs ready.

Beach Walks with Dr. Joe

PURPLE SEA URCHIN

With the late season storm Nicole a few weeks ago, we saw a lot of sand movement and some re-shaping of our beachfront. Nicole stirred up the water offshore for a few days also, and as a result, the rough water dislodged and uncovered some animals that live on the offshore bottom. Throughout this winter we have seen a few of these offshore animals along the beach where they have washed ashore. One example of this that we've noticed this winter is the Purple Sea Urchin.

Purple Urchins live on hard, solid and rocky bottoms. Along the Georgia coast, we have nice wide sandy beaches and inshore areas, so there really isn't any proper natural habitat for them close to the coast. They do live offshore on reefs, rocky hard bottom areas, and on artificial reefs. Occasionally Purple Urchins might be found along southeastern shorelines on rock jetties, and that is where I've seen them most often on the Georgia coast, on the long rock jetty at the south end of Cumberland Island.

During my years teaching marine sciences at Savannah State, a student would occasionally tell me that they had seen an urchin at Tybee. I'd ask where, and they usually would tell me North Beach jetty. I'd go out and look, but it was years before I ever found one myself! So, they tend to be scarce on Tybee, but usually when we do see them in the rocks, it is during the winter.

Sea Urchins belong to the Echinoderm (spiny-skin) group of animals that also includes starfish and sea cucumbers. Urchins usually have round, spherical bodies covered by a rigid shell-like test. Attached to the test are many moveable, long, pointed spines. Our Sand Dollar is actually a type of urchin where the test has become flattened, and the spines are reduced to tiny bristles. Like starfish, Sea Urchins have flexible tube feet with suction cups, and they use these long tube feet for moving across and clinging to hard rocky structures. On the bottom surface of the test, an urchin has a mouth, and just inside are five moveable "teeth" that are used for scraping



seaweed and other food off rocky structures.

The Purple Sea Urchin can be handled, but you want to do it carefully. The spines are sharp, and they break easily, so you would want to be very gentle with it, if you try to pick it up. If you happen to be around one of Tybee's rock jetties at low tide this winter, look around between the rocks, and you might be lucky enough to see a Purple Sea Urchin clinging to a rock. If you happen to find one washed up on the beach, the best chance for its survival will be if you would carry it to a jetty and place it in a tidepool.




