
WHO GETS BURNT by a FREEZER?

Served in a box of six, these cookies are 'barely baked' where it falls apart in your hand as you cram it into your face. Hands down, the best cookie in the land! Now, on to pizza land!

The pizza is great! We had two smalls, one Chicken, Ranch and Bacon situation and the other a **Deluxe**. The CRB is a perfect blend of all three; not too much of one and if you like all three of those decorations, you are going to love this pizza.

The **Deluxe** is equally delicious: a nice balance of all the pepperoni. sausage, shrooms, peppers, onions and plenty of mozzarella! Super reasonably priced and will fill up two kids or a large adult. One of the many things that Betsey and I both admired was that they include melted garlic butter for crust dippin'. Nothing says love like butter!

We did not know that Lighthouse Pizza has pasta! They offer both Spaghetti & Meatballs and Fettucine. We ordered the Sketti with **Meatballs**. It was a very large serving that comes with two breadsticks and pairing that with the Grilled Chicken Greek Salad, was dinner perfection! The pasta was nicely tender, and the meatballs were big and fat. Just how it should be.

The **Grilled Chicken Greek Salad** was clearly freshly made with crisp lettuce and all the Greek good stuff that comes with it. The chicken was yes, moist. It was moist and it was really good. Betsey must have commented on how good the chicken was at least four times. It is a great, light meal all in itself, but add some pasta with it, and it's a no fail lunch/dinner.

Naturally we had to try the Wings! They offer several flavors, but our go to is **Lemon Pepper**, so, that's where we went. Hand cut and house seasoned, the wings were on point and vanished fairly quickly.

We were really round at this point, but Betsey and I were in it to win it and ended the feast with their Blueberry Streusel Sticks. Covered in blueberry topping and frosting melted onto glorious dough, the Sticks are a mess of goodness and happiness. Throw in those cookies, and life is complete.

We were both pleasantly surprised by what Lighthouse has to offer. A variety of food that will have everyone in the family happy. With house made dough it really makes a difference.

Lighthouse is open Monday through Thursday from 3pm - 10pm and Friday through Sunday from 12pm to 10pm. Delivery is available every day. You can also order online and via DoorDash. There is no seating in house, so delivery and to go is a must.

Located smack dab in the middle of Tybrisa at 15 Tybrisa Street (next to Bernie's Oyster House), you can reach them at (912) 786-9874 or lighthousepizza.com. It is a perfect spot to grab food for the beach and/ or dinner at the hotel/house.

We will not see you there. I personally will be at home shoving Barely Baked Chocolate Chip Cookies into my yap.






