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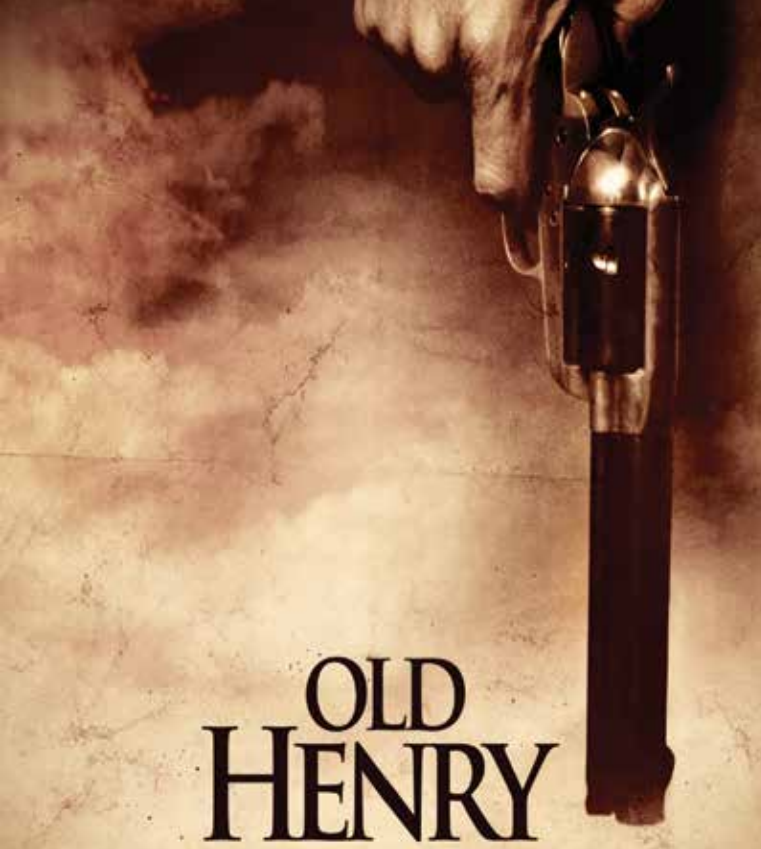

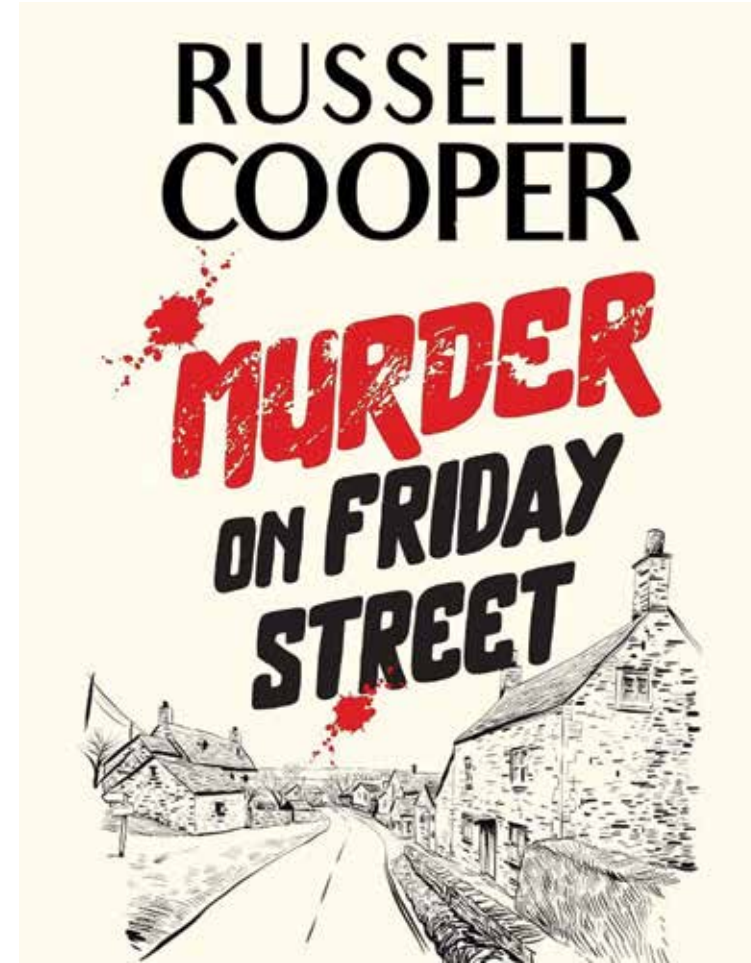

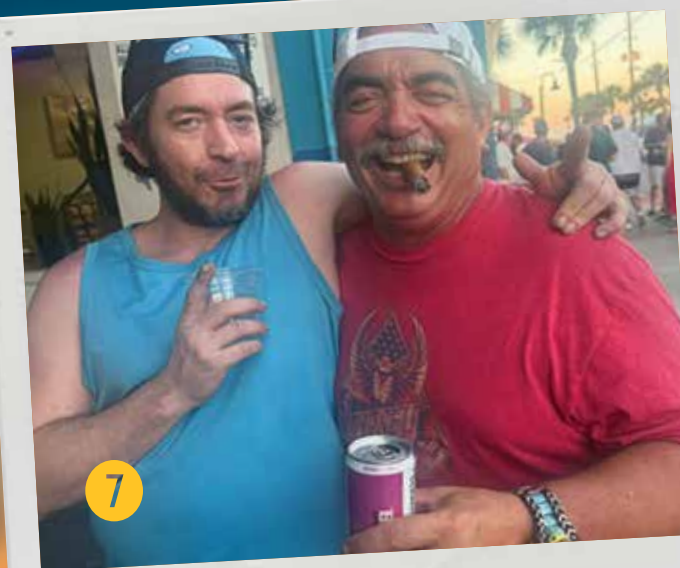

Beach Walks with Dr. Joe

Summer for Sand Fleas

As I have mentioned before, during some years a particular animal or seaweed will be more abundant than it usually is on Tybee. I have seen this at other beaches as well. During this summer, one of the animals that lives in the swash zone (where the water washes back and forth after each wave) has been more common than it usually is on Tybee. That animal is the *Mole Crab*, although most folks call them *Sand Fleas*.

With our big tidal range and wide, flat intertidal zone, the swash zone is constantly shifting. It moves down the beach front as the tide goes out, and migrates back up the beach as the tide rises. With this constant shifting, any animals that prefer to live in the swash zone must also be mobile and able to keep pace with their habitat moving up and down the beach as the tide rises and falls.

Along with tiny colorful *Coquina clams*, one of the best examples of a swash zone animal is the Mole Crab. Mole Crabs are a strange type of crab that really do not look like any other kind of crab. With their oval shaped body and short, jointed legs, they are well-designed for rapidly digging in the soft, water-saturated sand of the swash zone.

On some beaches, *Mole Crabs* are so abundant that anywhere you stick your hand down into the sand of the swash zone, you will dig one out. You will feel it tickling your hand as it frantically tries to dig, but instead scurries around in your palm. Do not worry. They do not pinch. On Tybee, they are not as abundant as I have seen on some North Carolina and Florida beaches where the wave energy is stronger, but we still get a few during the warmer months, and this summer we have found them regularly during our Tybee Beach Ecology Trips. It has been a good summer for *Sand Fleas*!

When you find a *Mole Crab*, lay it back down on the wet sand and watch



how it instantly digs back down. It will not go very deep, so do not worry about losing it. It actually digs backwards with its rear end leading the way. It will dig under the sand at a slight angle so that its head end is just barely below the surface. Once situated, the *Mole Crab* will extend its pair of feathery-like antennae out so that they lay just on top of the sand. As the water washes in and out after each wave, those antennae will catch tiny food particles. Sometimes, you might be able to see how the antennae cause a slight "V" in the water running across them.

Just like the *Coquina clams* do, *Mole Crabs* let the moving water of the swash zone carry them up and down the beach as the tides change. The result is that they always stay in the swash zone where predators from the water and from the air are less likely to find them.

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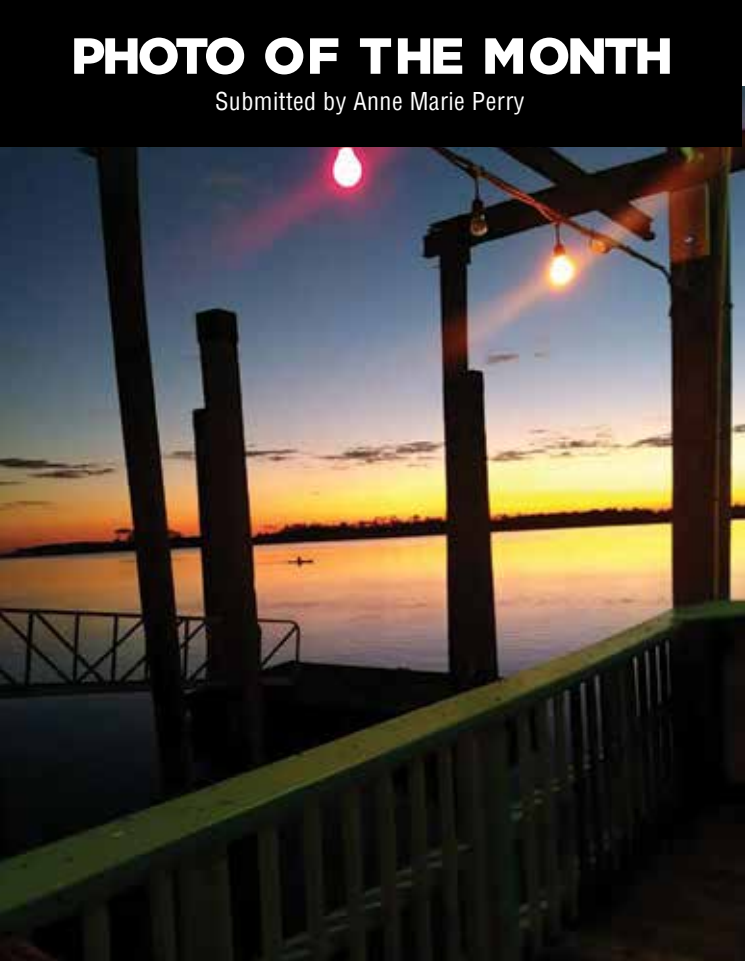

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Current STRs

TYBEE ISLAND IS AT A CROSSROADS!

How Many Short-Term Rentals (STRs) Are Enough?

Facts:

- Residents don't dislike tourism or resent visitors!
- There are just **too many** STRs - and neighborhoods are overwhelmed.
- More than **1,575** of Tybee's approximately **3,300 properties** have active short-term rental permits. Nearly **half of those rentals** (747) are located in neighborhoods that were zoned for residential living – and intended to be places where people live—not where a revolving door of vacationers replaces neighbors.
- On this map of our 3-mile island, each red dot represents an STR address/permit.
- For condos, each dot represents dozens - or even hundreds - of rentals units.
- **The 2024 STR Ordinance was adopted to restore balance. Today that balance is at risk.**
- The current proposal would add **243 additional STRs** on our residential streets - **making nuisance and harm conditions worse than those that led to reform in the first place.**
- **Code Enforcement needs dramatic improvement, but cannot solve the STR problem.**

Tourism and neighborhoods can coexist.

Even if every residential STR eventually disappeared, more than half of Tybee's existing vacation rentals would still remain in areas where they belong and can continue to serve visitors.

Protect the Tybee that people call home.

The 2024 ordinance represented years of thoughtful compromise and community consensus. Tell the Tybee Island Mayor and City Council: "Don't undo that progress!"

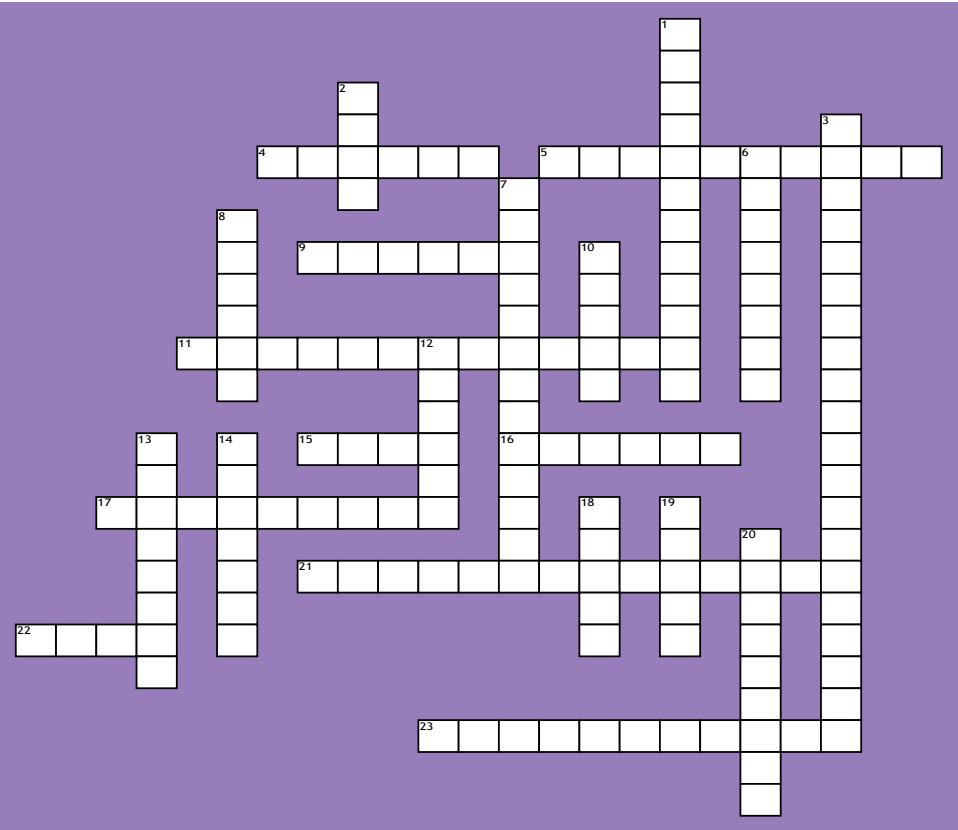
